

Yael Reshef (PhD 1999) is full professor at the department of Hebrew at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, and member of the Academy of the Hebrew Language. Her main research interest is the revival of Hebrew in speech and writing, focusing on linguistic, cultural and social aspects of the process. She won the Zeev Ben-Hayyim Award for excellence in research in the fields of Hebrew Language and Literature, was a senior member of “the Emergence of Modern Hebrew” research group at the Scholion Interdisciplinary Research Center in the Jack, Joseph and Morton Mandel School for Advanced Studies in the Humanities (2014-2016), and held visiting positions in the USA and Italy. She published 4 books, co-edited 2 books, and published more than 70 articles in English, Hebrew and Italian. She is currently co-editor of the journal *Language Studies* published by the Mandel Institute of Jewish Studies at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.
